

Fair Roulette

Fair Roulette, or American Roulette, is a variation of the classic French roulette.

It comes with coloured chips, a different one for each player. Coloured chips have the value of the table minimum but may take a different value at the player's discretion.

Winning bets are paid out as follows:

- Full: 35 times.
- Split/En Chaval: 17 times.
- Street/Carre: 8 times.
- Triplet: 11 times.
- Line.Sixain: 5 times.
- Dozen: 2 times.
- Column: 2 times.
- Simple chances: Even, Odd, Low Bet, High Bet, Red and Black are paid at par. The minimum bet on simple chances is indicated by displayed signs.

Payment of Zero (0)

If the ball falls on the zero '0', all bets that are not connected with that number lose, including simple chances, columns and dozens.
